SUBJECT: Depth perception requirement

1. Effective 16 December 2002 the following AFSC's now require normal depth perception: 1A131, 1A231, 1A331, 1A731, 1C131, 1C231. The change is made to coincide with the AFSC's requirement to perform scanner duties.
 2. Combat rescue officers are to be held to Pararescue standard (1T2X1) and will not be required to be tested for Depth perception.
 3. Any member that fails the OVT-ND depth perception test should be evaluated IAW AFI 48-123 A7.11.2. After a complete evaluation is performed a thorough AMS should be entered into AIMWTS and forwarded to HQ AETC along with the hard copy FCIII physical. These cases will be reviewed on a case by case basis for potential waiver.
